

13th Annual Performance Information

Friday, May 1st and Saturday, May 2nd

The information on this page is VERY important. Please read carefully and keep it until the performances are over.

-Each dancer will receive a free ticket for each show for a family member to use (It is attached to this info. Do not lose your free tickets, they are not replaceable). **Dancers DO NOT need a ticket to enter.** Please make sure you have the **CORRECT ticket** for the performance you are attending.

-Dancers need to **bring a bag with** their costume(s) (tights, shoes, accessories), performance t-shirt and black bottoms for the finale, WATER, and a snack. It is best if younger students come in their costumes. Tablets, books, coloring materials are also great to bring for the downtime in the dressing room.

-Dancers **MUST have their hair in a bun for ballet and magic mini tumbling, half up for shooting stars tumbling, and a ponytail for everything else (unless discussed differently by teacher)**, no part necessary. Makeup is optional, but please note that the stage lights may wash out their face if they are not wearing makeup.

-Dancers must remain **“backstage” in their designated class area in the cafeteria for the entire performance.** Stage moms are assigned to each class for help with changes, bathroom, and getting them on and off stage. Each stage mom will have a list of dancers they are in charge of and will be doing counts every 15 minutes to make sure they have their assigned dancers. If you remove your dancer from the dressing rooms, they will not be able to participate in the final bow at the end of the performance.

*Parents of our youngest dancers in Creative Movement 1 and Magic Minis Tumbling are welcome to stay backstage to help with their young dancer.

-We ask that only **ONE parent** comes back to the cafeteria to pick up their dancer after each performance and let your dancer's stage mom know you are taking them.

-Performance filming will be done on Saturday night's performance. Order forms will be available in the waiting area before the performances and at the front table during the performances. **Check or cash with the form must be turned in by the conclusion of Saturday's performance.**

-With this being said, flash photography and filming of any kind is prohibited.

Friday, May 1st:

-ALL dancers must arrive at **4:45pm SHARP** to the Walton High School cafeteria dressing room areas

Saturday, May 2nd:

-ALL dancers must arrive at **12:45pm SHARP** to the Walton High School cafeteria dressing room areas

Please enter through the side cafeteria doors and drop your dancers to their assigned stage mom.

-Parents MUST leave once their child is settled and MUST exit the building until the front doors open for the audience *Thank you for your corporation*
